The BSBC plays a significant role in helping to enrich the FCHS's soccer program and its associated extracurricular activities. Here is a list of objectives and activities which the BSBC funds and manages:

- 👤 To directly support the coaches with fundraising efforts, organizing volunteers and other activities to benefit the soccer athletes.
- 👤 To promote and encourage more young men and women to get involved in the high school soccer experience, either as an active participant or as a volunteer assistant.
- 👤 Financial Scholarships to cover dues and fees (for those students requiring financial assistance as approved by coaches and school administration)
- 👤 Coordinate Spirit Wear for athletes and fans (T-shirts, Sweatshirts, Gloves, Head Bands, Socks, etc. either as player gift or fundraiser)
- 👤 Provide athletic equipment, and accessories (as needed to augment the needs of each team when not supplied by the school)
- 👤 Provide post-season t-shirts for teams that make post-season play
- 👤 Provide coaches and/or trainers for pre-seasoning conditioning as needed
- 👤 Provide orthopedic medical doctors at all home games and first-aid equipment
- 👤 Maintain our own booster website in order to keep players and boosters updated
- 👤 Chef prepared healthy food supplied to all teams and support personnel for away games requiring bus transportation
- 👤 Bus transportation for teams and coaching/support staff (regular season, playoffs and tournaments, etc.)
- 👤 Provide annual printed Soccer Program
- 👤 Cover the costs for team tournaments
- 👤 Make available professional goalie training during regular season and playoffs as needed
- 👤 Provide coaches game wear, shirts, warm ups and jackets
- 👤 Coach's Achievement/Appreciation Awards
- 👤 Give-Aways of Prizes and Food at Games to Build Community and School Spirit
- 👤 Schedule student national anthem singers for all home games
- 👤 Fund the kickoff and post-season parties
- 👤 Coordinate announcers and scorekeepers
- 👤 Awarding an academic scholarship to a Senior each spring
